

FUEL REDUCTION PROGRAM ADMINISTRATOR

The Lower Musselshell Conservation District in Roundup, MT is looking to hire a fuel reduction program administrator to work directly with USDA-NRCS to further develop and administer the district Fuels Reduction Program.

Duties:

- Administer district defensible space program around homes and outbuildings.
- Develop and coordinate an expanded level of forest and fuels management, targeting landscape scale fuel reduction projects.
- Assist in completing forest inventories and write conservation plans in accordance with NRCS specifications;
- Provide outreach to the public in the form of workshops, news articles, demonstrations, etc.
- Identify and implement forestry conservation practices such as conifer encroachment, fuel breaks, pre-commercial thinning and brush management,

Skill Set Needed:

- Experience in natural resources, knowledge of forestry, fuel reduction for defensible space, fire fuels and behavior.
- Wildland Fire training and experience a plus, but not required.
- Experience in administration, grant writing and project plan development.
- Good verbal, writing, computer and organizational skills; be able to work independently.
- Be able to traverse rough terrain, analyze timber and fuels.
