Grant-Funded Programs:

1. Education & Outreach Mini-Grant Program

- a. FY2019 contract: Ongoing management with many requests for subaward extensions or amendments due to COVID.
- b. FY2020 contract: Working with DEQ to finalize Spring 2021 Call for Applications. \$24,000 available for subawards.
- c. FY2021 DEQ 319 application for Mini-Grant funding in 2022 has been accepted. Contract pending (\$33,090).

2. Flathead Basin Wastewater Partnership (FBWP)

- a. FBWP MOU finalized
- b. BSWC member, Jillian Henrichon, started on 01/11 and will spearhead FBWP efforts
- c. \$30,000 available for Septic Maintenance cost-share in priority areas of the Basin

1. Ranching for Rivers

- a. 2 Projects completed in the Blackfoot River Watershed
- b. 2 Projects currently encumbered (\$11,468.40)
- c. \$50,508.60 available in cost-share
- d. Grant agreement extended to Dec. 15th, 2021.

2. Watershed Stewardship Funding

- a. \$ 10,975 encumbered for subawarded program with the Gallatin Conservation District
- b. \$ 6,125 encumbered as 50% of cost for shared BSWC member under the Flathead Basin Wastewater Partnership efforts

3. District Assistance & Communications

- a. Added new users to the email network, maintained lists, continued identifying and correcting errors with internal and partner contacts.
- b. Fulfilled 3 website assistance requests to CD's.
- c. Assisted CDs with recording meetings, screen sharing, and call-in features for virtual meetings as well as train hosts on Zoom/UberConference features on an individual basis.
- d. Created drafts of outreach material for 2021 legislative session.
- e. Pending DNRC RFP for continued funding

NRCS Contribution Agreements

1. Conservation Delivery Agreement (Pollinators, Soil Health, & Conservation Stories)

- a. Agreement expires August, 2021. Waiting for notice on possible extension.
- b. Soil Health: Planning for 2022 Soil Health Symposium, planning meetings will resume on January 28th.
- c. BSWC: Supporting 4 host sites, Lake CD, Missoula Weed District, BPMC and CEMIST.
 - i. \$24,500 total in funding to the above organizations

2. Montana Conservation Partnership Initiative

a. Subawards

i. MRCDC: \$49,436.64

ii. Valley CD/MRWA: \$100,000.00

iii. Blackfoot Challenge: \$30,000.00

b. Sage Grouse Initiative:

Bridger Plant Materials Center

- Decision was made to postpone the LCC transition until after the MACD-SWCDM merger was completed. Currently working with Theresa on a 2021 budget. There will be a board meeting in mid-March.
