## Resolution to Encourage Non-Governmental Organizations to "Qualify" for Ag **Status Taxation**

#### **BACKGROUND DESCRIBING ISSUE \***

Non-Governmental Organizations (NGO) are given tax exemption under the 501 c3; they may also be given property tax exemption depending on the nature of their charitable interest. Across Montana we are seeing several NGO entities purchase lands that mainly serve a purpose for agriculture use and use them for more recreational purposes. Due to their tax-exempt status this could very likely negatively affect the tax base resulting in loss of funds that organizations like Conservation Districts use to continue to function and protect soil, air, and water.
